We are providing you with the reports on the activity from the workshop sessions for your review and use in preparation for the committee meeting at convention. Please keep in mind that all of the information that has been distributed up to this point has been to help us all prepare to make decisions on the amendments in the committee meeting as well as in plenary session. We will proceed in committee with the understanding that you, your club's voting representative, are prepared to move forward with the committee's work.

There are a few notes to remember as you do your preparation.

- Chart Format. The reports are in chart format similar to that used for the Constitution and Bylaws amendments. Aside from the expected information (article, section, title, etc), you will see that the **IN-PERSON** reports are in **BLACK** while the **VIRTUAL** reports are in **BLUE**.
- Side-By-Side. You will need to refer to your copies of the Constitution and Bylaws charts that were initially distributed because the complete texts of the original language as well as the proposed amendments are in those original documents.
