Prince Jonah Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole Award

Outstanding Hawaiian Civic Club of the Year

The Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs seeks to recognize an outstanding Hawaiian Civic Club that best exemplifies the ideals and example set forth by Prince Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole through service, dedication, and active involvement throughout the previous calendar year.

- Only Hawaiian Civic Clubs in good standing with the Association of Hawaiian Civic Clubs may be nominated for this award.
- Nominees **must not** have received this award in the last five years.
- **Nomination form MUST be received NOT LATER THAN 60 days prior to the Convention start date via email and MUST include 2 different digital group photos of the club members. NOTE: Late submissions will NOT be accepted.**
- The winner of this prestigious award will be announced at the Annual AHCC Convention.

Nominees of the Prince Jonah Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole Award will be judged on the following criteria:

1. Exemplifies the ideals and example set forth by Prince Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole.
2. Active involvement in the Hawaiian Civic Club movement and the community at-large throughout the previous calendar year.
3. Contributes, supports and furthers the causes of the Hawaiian community and Hawaiian Civic Clubs throughout the previous calendar year.
4. Demonstrates knowledge of Hawaiian values and principles.

SUBMISSION PROCEDURE:

- **All submissions must be received NOT LATER THAN 60 days prior to the Convention start date via email (not US Mail) using provided MS Word document** (.pdf scan of Word document is also allowed).
- Each submission should be sent as an attachment to an email – only **ONE** submission per email.
- The subject line of the email should reflect the award name and the name of the submitting club.
- The group photos of club members must of good quality (digital camera picture of 10MP or higher is recommended). Please note: Additional pictures are highly encouraged, but not required and will have no bearing upon judging criteria.
- Upon receipt of nomination forms, a confirmation email will be sent to the nominating individual or club. **NOTE:** If you do not receive this confirmation email within 3 days of submission, please send a follow-up email requesting the status of your submission.
- Nominees for the Prince Jonah Kūhiō Kalanianaʻole Award Outstanding Hawaiian Civic Club of the Year must submit an electronic slideshow 'display' to Convention as an enhancement to their written submission. **Written submission must still be received by posted deadline.** Slideshow must be a Microsoft PowerPoint 97-2016 presentation and be sent electronically to the Awards Chair by the submission deadline. Presentation must be 30 or less PowerPoint slides.
